**Re: Algonquin Power Co. (“Algonquin”) – Proposed Amherst Island Wind Facility,  
Ontario (the “Project”)**

As Algonquin is aware we are the solicitors for the Association for the Protection of Amherst Island (“APAI”).

On January 2, 2012, APAI provided Algonquin with a detailed technical report prepared by Dr. John Harrison regarding the Project. As a result, Algonquin has been informed that, if erected, many of the turbines have a high probability of being out of compliance with the current Ontario Ministry of Environment standards for wind energy generating systems.

We are writing today to further advise that if the turbines are erected, APAI will forthwith be retaining a qualified acoustical consultant to audit turbines for compliance.

If any turbine(s) are found to be non-compliant, amongst other remedies, APAI will be applying to the Ontario Superior Court of Justice seeking an injunction to stop the operation of any non – compliant turbine(s).

Given that Algonquin has been clearly informed that there is a high probability that many turbines will be out of compliance, APAI and/or its members reserve the right to bring further civil claims for damages, including punitive, aggravated and exemplary damages.
